A YEAR IN REVIEW...

The last 21 months have been truly riveting. In the midst of unpredictability, we endeavored to identify opportunities wherever possible. Ignatian spirituality held us together as we sought God in ALL-- the moments of surprise, frustration, and challenge. Before the COVID-19 pandemic, we began working on our strategic plan to reflect on the evolution of LIS since its inception in 1997. After the pandemic's interruption of our planning, we remain focused on reimagining ways to meet seekers where they are emotionally, spiritually, financially and logistically. Tailoring retreats and workshops to current events and social teachings have been fortifying throughout the last year and will continue into the next.



- 1700+ hours of instruction, connection and spiritual development
- 1000+ participants across all programs and events
- 120 participants in formation courses
- 46 LIS Associates who helped coordinate, lead, teach, and facilitate throughout the year
- 36 retreatants in Spiritual Exercises
- 31 graduates from 3-year formation programs
- 14 different states and countries represented throughout the year
- 9 collaborations with other ministries on spirituality, social justice, and discernment

All English and Spanish programs and events were held virtually for the entire year. The numbers reflect activity from July 2020-June 2021.

\$5,000 will provide retreats, workshops in discernment and leadership, and continuing education for spirituality leaders in ministry.


\$1,000 will support those making the Spiritual Exercises in Daily Life (19th Annotation Retreat) over the course of the year.

\$500 will allow us to offer a workshop or a conference on Ignatian Spirituality to a specific group or parish community.



As with most organizations, the main focus this year was to remain open and afloat. In the early years of LIS, investment funds were established to partially support its functions and secure its financial position in difficult times. Without it, LIS would have had to close its doors this past year. While grateful for the reprieve that these funds offer, it is not a sustainable model that we can rely on indefinitely.

The decline in Programs and Contributions income was expected and understandable. Expenses were cut where possible. However, every program was held without interruption and considerations were made to ensure that every participant was able to finish what they started.
